We offer 1–2-1 appointments, workshops, and Maths and Stats support.



Bangor Celebrates Chinese New Year

This year, Bangor celebrates Chinese New Year – Year of the Rooster – with a Chinese dragon parade and gala on Saturday 4 February, organised by Bangor University's Confucius Institute.

Performers from the Confucius Institutes at Bangor University and London South Bank University will join pupils from Our Lady's School for a vibrant display of Chinese culture throughout the afternoon. A Chinese dragon, 15 metres long, will wind its way down the High Street, accompanied by costumed dancers and drummers. This will be followed by a gala to celebrate Chinese New Year, featuring Chinese song and dance, instrumental pieces and a special Chinese/Welsh duet of *Ar Hyd y Nos (All Through the Night*).

Special guests on the day include Mayor of the City, Councillor Dewi Williams, and local actress Angharad Rhodes, best known for her leading role in the CBeebies television series *Melody*.



Sustainability Lab - Fruit for future generations across Bangor

Bangor Students Union is set to boost a new student lead urban campus greening project in Bangor city centre this year, with a plan to plant forty new fruit trees in Bangor University's grounds. Studies show that trees bring people happiness as well as promote healthy living and ensure benefits for wildlife including birds and bees through habitat creation.

Gabe Hibberd, project coordinator said, "Increasing wildlife and promoting healthy diets is what we're all about. It's not just about planting trees, the benefits are much more far reaching."



The project has been taken on by <u>Hub Cymru Africa</u>, the Welsh Government Assembly's link network with African development programmes, and a sister project has been started at Makerere University in Uganda to match Bangor's planting tree for tree.

Keep an eye out around campus for new trees, and the promise they bring of blossom in spring!
